

Base Camping Gear List:

- Waterproof Tent (Remember: “4-Person Tent” Sleeps 2 With 2 Full Gear Packs)
- Waterproof Tarp (This Should Be Used Underneath Your Tent)
- Per Person: Sleeping Bag (Zero Degree Mummy Bag Or Wool Blankets)
- Per Person: Foam Ground Guards Or Wool Blankets (For Ground Insulation)
- Per Person: Outdoor / Hunting-Type Clothing (Consider Dressing In Layers)
 - Long Pants, Long Sleeves, & Several Pairs Of Socks
 - Hat
 - Boots Or Rugged Shoes
 - Handkerchief/Bandana
 - Base Layer (No Cotton T-Shirts)
 - Waterproof Jacket
 - Change Of Clothes/Shoes, Warm Socks, Poly/Wool Gloves (2 Pair Each)
- Per Person: Mess Kit, Spork, Camping Chair, Towel
- Per Family: Small First Aid Kit, Insect Repellent, Sun Protection, & Tick Repellent
- Per Family: Small Trowel & Toilet Paper In A Plastic Bag; Wet Wipes
- Recommended: Water, Snacks, Propane Stove For Coffee, Ice Cooler, Hatchet
- Optional: Folding Tables, Cleaning Tubs, Trash Bags
- Optional: Hand-Pump (Unless stated we camp at sites with water access)

Field Gear List (Per Person):

- Day Pack To Hold Miscellaneous Gear, Snacks, & Water
- Pocket Knife Pen Rosary Compass Matches Flashlight Whistle
- Canteen/Thermos (Minimum 2 Qt. Per Person)

Please perform thorough due diligence before purchasing any camping gear. We will provide recommendations if so desired

Campsite Rules:

General Safety

- No running or horseplay allowed in camping area
- No walking in between tents
- Anytime a knife is used it must be used in the designated area(s)
- Permission is required to enter and exit the campsite area

Fire Safety

- Absolutely no horseplay around fire
- Do not add wood without firemaster or adult approval
- Do not remove wood or sticks
- Absolutely no garbage in fire

Camp Cleanliness

- Garbage must be put in the designated area(s)
- Any supplies that need drying must be dried in the designated area(s)
- Camping gear must remain in tent
- Cooking equipment must remain in mess area

Camp Respect

- Address all fathers as 'sir' and all officers by their title
- Saluting officers is mandatory
- Silence during "Lights Out" period
- Respect God's majestic landscape
